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I, Candi-Lee:Weeks A living Man/Woman, in this court of record **Claim & Declare:**

EDWARD, by the grace of God, King of England, Lord of Ireland, and Duke of Guian[27], to all those that these present letters shall hear or see, greeting. Know ye that we, to the honor of God and of Holy Church, and to the profit of our realm, have granted for us and our heirs, that the Charter of liberties, and the Charter of the forest[28], which were made by common assent of all the realm, in the time of King HENRY our father, shall be kept in every point without breach. (2) And we will that the same charters shall be sent under our seal, as well to our justices of the forest, as to others, and to all sheriffs of shires, and to all our other officers, and to all our cities throughout the realm, together with our writs, in the which it shall be contained, that they cause the foresaid charters to be published, and to declare to the people that we have confirmed them in all points; (3) and that our justices, sheriffs, mayors, and other ministers, which under us have the laws of our land to

3. guide, shall allow the said charters pleaded before them in
4. judgment in all their points, that is to wit, the Great Charter
5. as the common law[*] and the Charter of the forest, for the
6. wealth of our realm.

7. **2.** AND we will, That if any judgment be given from henceforth
8. contrary to the points of the charters aforesaid by the justices,
9. or by any other our ministers that hold plea before them against
10. the points of the charters, it shall be undone, and holden for
11. nought.

12. **3.** AND we will, That the same charters shall be sent, under our
13. seal, to cathedral churches throughout our realm, there to
14. remain, and shall be read before the people two times by the
15. year.

16. **4.** AND that all archbishops and bishops shall pronounce the
17. sentence of excommunication against all those that by word, deed,
18. or counsel do contrary to the foresaid charters, or that in any
19. point break or undo them. (2) and that the said curses be twice a
20. year denounced and published by the prelates aforesaid. (3) And
21. if the said prelates, or any of them, be remiss in the
22. denunciation of the said sentences, the archbishops of Canterbury
23. and York for the time being shall compel and distrein them to the
24. execution of their duties in form aforesaid.

25. **5.** AND for so much as divers people of our realm are in fear that
26. the aids and tasks[29] which they have given to us beforetime
27. towards our wars and other business, of their own grant and good
will (howsoever they were made) might turn to a bondage to them
and their heirs, because they might be at another time found in
the rolls, and likewise for the prises taken throughout the realm

2. by our ministers: (2) We have granted for us and our heirs, that
3. we shall not draw such aids, tasks, nor prises into a custom, for
4. any thing that hath been done heretofore, be it by roll or any
5. other precedent that may be founden.

7. 6. Moreover we have granted for us and our heirs, as well to
8. archbishops, bishops, abbots, priors, and other folk of holy
9. church, as also to earls, barons, and to all the communalty of
10. the land, that for no business from henceforth we shall take such
11. manner of aids, tasks, nor prises, but by the common assent of
12. the realm, and for the common profit thereof, saving the ancient
13. aids, and prises due and accustomed.

14. 7. AND for so much as the more part of the communalty of the
15. realm find themselves sore grieved with the maletent of wools,
16. that is to wit, a toll of forty shillings for every sack of wool,
17. and have made petition to us to release the same; We at their
18. requests have yearly released it, and have for granted us and our
19. heirs, that we shall not take such things without their common
20. assent and good will, saving to us and our heirs the custom of
21. wools, skins, and leather, granted before by the communalty
22. aforesaid. In witness of which things we have caused these our
23. letters to be made patents. Witness EDWARD our son at London the
24. tenth day of October, the five and twentieth year of our reign.

reign of Henry III, as a supplement to Magna Carta. It was

confirmed by him in 1225. Some of the provisions omitted in the reissues of Magna Carta which relate to forest matters appeared in the Charter of the Forest.
